

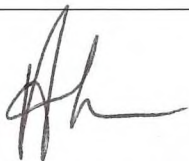

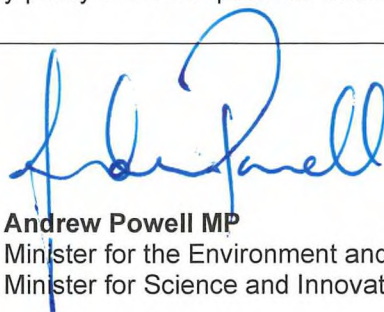

Minor and machinery in nature	The purpose of the proposal is to commence provisions within the <i>Environmental Protection (Efficiency and Streamlining) and Other Legislation Amendment Act 2026</i> to support the delivery of the single integrated permission for tourism activities on protected areas, State forests, recreation areas and State marine parks under the government's 20-year tourism plan, <i>Destination 2045 - Delivering Queensland's Tourism Future</i>. This proposal is machinery in nature and does not result in a substantive change to regulatory policy or new impacts on business, government or the community.
