

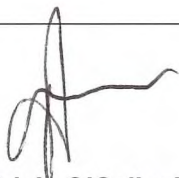

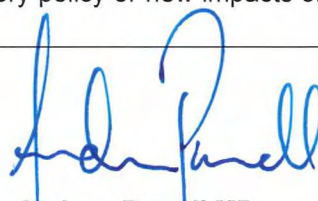

Minor and machinery in nature	The Proclamation fixes 1 June 2026 for the commencement of part 2 of the <i>Major Sports Facilities and Other Legislation Amendment Act 2026</i>, to the extent it is not in force, related to the <i>Major Events Act 2014</i>. The Department has assessed the proposal as machinery in nature, as the Proclamation only has the effect of commencing amendments to the <i>Major Events Act 2014</i>, not yet commenced, and does not result in a substantive change to regulatory policy or new impacts on business, government or the community.
